

WASHINGTON D.C.

Then you will tour the local sites, including the famous Smithsonian museums, historic monuments and of course the White House. NOVA SCOTIA

See the settlement areas at **Markland** and **Lockeport** and revisit the sinking of the Titanic at the Maritime Museum in Halifax, while also exploring this dynamic seaside city and scenic province, including Peggy's Cove and the Swiss Memorial.
